




BUILDING STRONG FAMILIES FOR GOD

Simplified Sermon Takeaways

In Isaiah 53:5, This verse tells us that Jesus was hurt and punished for the wrong things we do so that we could have peace and be close to God. Because of His love, Jesus took our pain and made a way for us to be forgiven.

Questions to Engage

- What did Jesus do for us in this verse?
- How do you feel knowing Jesus was hurt for us to have peace?
- How can we show thankfulness to Jesus for His love?

Family Spiritual Fitness Challenge:

This week, take time as a family to talk about what it means to be forgiven and to forgive others. Read Isaiah 53:5 together and think of one way you can show love or kindness to someone, just like Jesus showed love for us. Write it down and share your acts of kindness at the end of the week!
